

Description of the duties of the Special Talent Commission Unit

In the Name of God

The Secretariat of the Special Commission for Talents and the University Olympiad is responsible for identifying, nurturing and guiding the talented students of the University. In order to perform these tasks, in addition to the efforts made by the Secretariat of Talents within the scope of its authority at the university to identify, nurture and support talented students, it is obliged to provide facilities in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Health and Medical Education. Talented students have been approved to provide services in the form of educational, research and welfare facilities as follows:

Educational Facilities

- Facilities for entering higher education.
- Taking general courses in absentia.
- Passing a maximum of 27 courses per semester.
- Simultaneous study in one of the undergraduate or MPH majors for medical students or MD-PhD for medical internship students.
- Establishing training classes for the Olympiad of medical students and supporting the participating students.

Welfare Facilities

- Establish facilities for the use of libraries, laboratories and computer sites.
- Cooperation with the Student Vice Chancellor for granting loans and scholarships, dormitories and pilgrimage, recreational and sports facilities.
- Preparation of scientific resources.
- Holding a special conference for brilliant talents.
